Additional Club Information

Arriving at the Club:

Upon arriving at the top of the driveway where the parking lot begins, take the second right hand turn and continue all the way down to the roundabout. There, our Golf Operations Staff will assist you with your golf clubs. Once you've parked, please check in at the Pro Shop to receive information about our facilities and ensure you have everything you need before teeing off.

Golf Carts:

Golf carts are available, however, we highly recommend booking in advance to ensure availability. Please contact the Pro Shop at (613) 692-2072 or ask your host member to reserve one for you.

Pace of Play:

To ensure the Rideau View experience is enjoyable for members and their guests, it is important that all players are aware of and adhere to our agreed upon Pace of Play objectives.

- 1st tee time to 9am Play in 3 hours and 30 minutes or less
- 9am 10am Play in 3 hours and 45 minutes or less
- 10am and later Play in sub 4 hours
- 9 holes must be completed within 2 hours
- 12 holes must be completed within 2 hours and 40 minutes

Extreme Weather Policy:

The golf club is equipped with a lightning detection system located on the roof of the Pro Shop. When the warning horn sounds (one long blast), all members and guests must immediately leave the golf course and practice facilities. Please seek shelter in the Clubhouse, Pro Shop, or your vehicle. For safety reasons, players must remain in a secure location until the all-clear signal (three short blasts) is sounded.

Practice Facilities:

West End: Located between the 1st and 10th tees, the West End features 18 artificial turf hitting stations and a 10,000 sq. ft. putting green with chipping aprons. A large fairway style landing area includes colour-coded yardage markers every 25 yeards from 100 to 250 yards.

East End: Designed for skills development, the East End offers a short game area with three target greens (up to 75 yard shots), two bunkers (greenside and fairway), and a grass tee for long game practice. This area supports extended sessions without interfering with West End users.

Practice Facility Rules

- Practice balls are available at both ends.
- Full flight yellow balls are provided in buckets at all stations.
- White limited flight balls (less 20%) are available for those with high dispersion or long carry (>275 yards).

Methods of Payment:

We accept Debit, Visa, and Mastercard, as well as payments through our Member Account chit system. Please note that we do not accept cash or American Express. Thank you for your understanding!

Course Etiquette:

Please note that it is prohibited to take a push cart between bunkers and greens.

We also kindly remind all members and guests to:

- Fill your divots sand is available in bottles at the first tee or in bins on the electic carts.
- Rake the bunkers after use.
- Keep carts at least 30 feet away from the greens and stay on cart paths when available.

Women's Dress Code



Shorts and skirts must be a respectful length, with built-in shorts fully covered.



Crew neck sweaters are permitted, provided they are worn over a collared shirt.



Long sleeve shirts, including UV-protection shirts are permitted even if they do not have a collar.



Tailored golf pants, including tight-ankle styles, are permitted.



Golf dresses must be a respectful length, with built in shorts fully covered.



Hats must be always worn forward and removed inside the Main Dining Room.



Quarter zips, vest, and knit sweaters are permitted.



Athletic-style hoodies that are fitted and made from performance materials are permitted.

Men's Dress Code



Golf shirts must be tucked in.



Quarter zips, vests, and knit sweaters are permitted.



Tailored golf shorts of a reasonable length above the knee are permitted.



Athletic-style hoodies that are fitted and made from performance materials are permitted.



Hats must be always worn forward and removed inside the Main Dining Room.



Tailored golf pants, including tight ankle pants are permitted.



Golf-specific soft spike or spike less shoes are permitted.
